

Tracking student progress in Ascend Math is an easy and effective way to motivate and reward students for their time and effort. The following describes common ways in which teachers reward students.

Completing Objectives

One way to track rewards virtually is to use a google sheet to track student progress on objectives completed. This may be maintained virtually by creating a google sheet that you could post as a virtual bulletin board. Feel free to copy this [google sheet](#) for your use.

- 1 objective completed = 1 cell
- ***1 objective is completed in ONE attempt = 1 cell
- 1 level completed = 5 to 10 tickets/stars/stamp

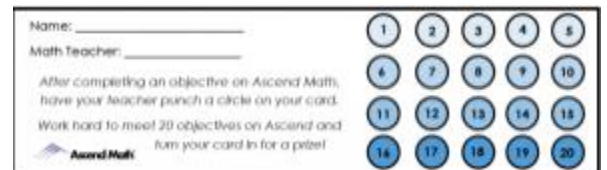
Refer to the Activity Completion Report to view the number of objectives completed by each student. Go to the reports tab, select Favorite Reports Activity Completion Report.

Teachers can track objectives completed and have them available when school resumes. 
