Pause Student Feature

Ascend Math added a new feature, *Pause Student*, to help school administrators and teachers better recognize when a student is struggling with a particular lesson. This will allow teachers to intervene and help students with the objective. Live Student Tracker - Refresh for updates



The Live Student Tracker provides realtime information for each student in a class suggesting opportunities for small group instruction and informing teacher immediately if students are struggling and in need of intervention.

The Live Student Tracker provides critical, real-time information for each student in the class including:

- · Current level, unit, and objective
- Post assessment attempts, time of last attempt, and recent result
- The next objective in that student's study plan
- Links to print study guides, individually and batched

If the student's name is **green and bold**, they are currently logged into their Ascend Math account.
