MIDDLE SCHOOL RESPONSE TO INTERVENTION

Intervention Case Study

Background

Students at Nolan Middle School in Manatee County, Florida enjoyed significant gains in their math achievement by using The Ascend[®] Math Solution. Out of the 201 students who attended remediation classes at school, there was a total increase of 2,727 points on the NRT. The average gain was 22.17 points per student. 
